Things to know when planning CPR and First Aid Training

Th NHADA Workers' Compensation Trust realizes the importance of proper training in health and safety. We encourage you to take advantage of this reimbursement program to better protect the health and safety of your employees.

OSHA regulations stipulate that when a medical facility for treatment of injured employees is not available near the workplace, some person or persons there must be trained to offer first aid. OSHA further states that an accident victim should receive medical treatment within four minutes to be considered in near proximity. Be prepared!

The CPR Training certification is for one year and the First Aid Training certification is for three years.

The following checklist will assist you in planning your company's CPR and First Aid training session.

DETERMINE YOUR COMPANY'S TRAINING NEEDS-

- _____ Decide how many people in your company should be certified in CPR and First Aid.
- _____ Find out who in your company is currently certified in CPR and First Aid.
- _____ Find out who in your company is interested in becoming certified in CPR and First Aid. If more than 25 percent of your employees or other family members participate on their own time, it is up to you to decide whether that training will be paid by the company or by the participants. However, the
- Red Cross will provide one invoice to the company.

DETERMINE THE METHOD OF TRAINING FOR YOUR COMPANY-

- _____ Does your company have enough interest to schedule a special session for your employees?
- If so, do you have adequate facilities to offer the training on-site?
 - A room with tables and chairs, a television and VCR, and room to practice will be needed.
 - Check specifics with your local Red Cross Chapter.
- When would be the best time for your company to offer this program? Find the time that's right for you.
- Would you be better served to sign your employees up to participate in a community-sponsored training session?
- WHEN YOU HAVE DETERMINED YOUR COMPANY'S NEEDS AND WANTS, CALL YOUR LOCAL RED CROSS CHAPTER. A LIST OF NEW HAMPSHIRE CHAPTERS IS ON THE BACK OF THIS PAGE. Since each Chapter is run independently, the charges, class sizes and course schedules differ. They will assist you in scheduling the CPR and/or First Aid training that meets your needs.
- Once your training has been scheduled, be sure to remind your employees, and remove as many obstacles as possible from their ability to follow through and attend!
- _____ NHADA Workers' Compensation Trust will send reimbursements to NHADA WCT members only.
- _____ NHADA members that do not have Workers' Compensation but DO have medical coverage through NHAD Services, Inc. - Insurance Division, will be reimbursed through that entity subject to the same rules and restrictions.
